

- Originally Developed in 2000
- Designed with input from 18 HIDTAs
- 15 years of active user membership
- Over 100,000 activities processed per year
- Over 700 state, federal, and local participating agencies

Features



Additional Features

- The HIDTA maintains full control of its users' access and privilege
- Seven target types
 - Person
 - Weapon
 - Vehicle
 - Address
 - Internet
 - Account
 - Phone
- System determines event radius
- SAFETNet is a pointer system
- Contains no case-specific data
- Users have sole access to their entries




Officer Safety

- Instant notifications
- Notifications via on-screen, text, email
- "Need to know basis only"
- Multiple points of contact
- User database audited

Nationwide Deconfliction

- Events and targets
- All instances with the exception of NY/NJ currently hosted by El Paso Intelligence Center (EPIC)
 - *Future development - Deconfliction and Information Coordination Endeavor (DICE) connection
- Subject Targets & Events are deconflicted nationwide with other partnered systems
 - Case Explorer
 - RISSafe
- Intra-HIDTA Deconfliction
 - HIDTAs utilizing SAFETNet
